

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop initially hiring four individuals. Product sales for their first year of operation amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and various components. During 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is among the leading global makers in the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. Throughout the last 60 years, the trade of material handling has grown into a very advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade at present continues to grow as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and different associated products. The company feels assured in their potential in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and selling hydraulic accessories. Construction was completed in the year 1956 on a new facility in order to house all of the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Moreno Valley. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the United States with places in Springfield, Moreno Valley, Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured internationally due to lots of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This plant is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in blades.
